

CLUB100 Rules

- The name of the Club shall be **CLUB100**.
- The object of the Club shall be to raise funds for the Wendover Arm Trust.
- CLUB100** is open exclusively to current members of the Wendover Arm Trust who are aged 18 years or more.

The total prize money each year shall be about 50% of the total subscribed in that year.

Prize allocation for each draw, based on a Club membership of 100, shall be in the proportion:

1st Prize	£120
2nd Prize	£50
3rd Prize	£20

If applications are received for more or fewer than 100 subscriptions, the amount of each prize will be increased or decreased proportionately.
- CLUB100** shall be run on an annual basis and the annual subscription of fifteen pounds entitles the Member to take part in four consecutive prize draws.
- A member of **CLUB100** may have more than one subscription and each additional subscription will count as an additional **CLUB100** member.
- If the membership of the Wendover Arm Trust lapses, the membership of the **CLUB100** scheme will also lapse.
Any monies paid will be treated as a donation to the Trust.
- All winners will be notified by post and the results will be published in the Wendover Arm News and on the Trust's website; your name will be identified if you have ticked the box on the application form.
- Administration of **CLUB100** will be controlled by the Council of the Wendover Arm Trust and all decisions of the Council shall be final and binding on all questions relating to its operation.

Why CLUB100?

CLUB100 is the Wendover Arm Trust's Members-only lottery.

The Trust's aims are to restore the scenic and tranquil navigation from Bulbourne all the way back to Wendover for the benefit of boaters, anglers, walkers and to provide or improve recreational areas for the local population. By restoring the canal the flora and fauna in the locality will also benefit.

Most of the Trust's income is from unpredictable sources such as donations, fund-raising events, legacies and grants; the income from membership subscriptions and **CLUB100** provides it with a base level of income from which it can plan its restoration activities.

The Trust has come a long way since the restoration work started in earnest in 1990. Most of the 6¾ miles of the canal had remained in water throughout the years to maintain its original and essential function of ensuring a supply for the Grand Union Summit level, but only 1¼ miles from Bulbourne junction remained navigable, with 2½ miles of dry bed and the remaining water unnavigable.

By 2005 much of the preparatory work for restoration had been done and a quarter-mile section from Tringford pumping station re-built that allows full-length boats to navigate the arm and turn round to go back to the Grand Union's main line. Of the remaining 2¼ miles of 'dry' canal just under 1¾ miles is now fully restored and completion of the remainder will increase the navigable length to 3¼ miles.

Most of the work of the Trust is done by volunteers. Help them complete the task by joining **CLUB100** – our volunteers win – and you may win too. If you are not yet a member, then join up and take part.
