September Working Party

At the September working party backfilling banks with spoil above the coir rolls for Stage 2 commenced and 46 metres was completed on the towpath side and 60 metres on the offside. Both banks were sown with grass seed. In addition the formwork for the first wall section of the Stage 2 mooring wall was completed ready for a ready-mix pour at the start of the October working party.

At the October working party work commenced on laying the Bentomat lining on the bed of Stage 2 and continued by placing spoil above the coir rolls on both banks enabling 60 metres of bed lining to be

completed. The rapid progress made on lining in four months can be seen in the two photographs opposite.

The first three wall sections of the Stage 2 mooring wall were completed, surplus ready-mix concrete being used to form the 'sleeping policemen' over the joints in the Bentomat bed lining.

Improved bending frame

Ron Pittaway recently modified the design of the bending frame that he made in 1999 for bending our reinforcement. On October 13th the new frame was tested by a small team led by Pete Bowers and proved highly successful. All remaining half-sheets of reinforcement were bent ready for future use in reinforced concrete walls.

November Working Party

Weather permitting, it is intended to strip and reassemble the wall formwork ready for pouring the fourth wall section late on the Saturday morning. If this is successful the formwork will be stripped and re-assembled on Sunday/Monday morning for another pour later on Monday and again on Tuesday/Wednesday for a final pour on Thursday. This will complete the Stage 2 mooring wall.

Bank filling will continue with the aim of completing the first 100 metres of Stage 2 and 80 metres of bed lining before winter sets in.

General Notes.

All volunteers receive and sign for the Trust's Restoration Handbook that includes full Health and Safety requirements for the restoration works.

The handbook is the property of the Trust; if you leave the working parties for any reason, please return your Handbook to either Ray Orth or myself.

Hard hats for use at all times and high visibility jackets to be worn on sites with mobile plant in use are kept in the store at Tringford and must be drawn/returned there.

One first aid kit is kept in the store, one in the Transit tipper and two are available for up to two working sites. Mike Wright has successfully renewed his Fist Aid qualification for another three years, well done Mike.

Also available in the store at Tringford are ear defenders and goggles that must be worn when using strimmers, angle grinders, concrete breakers and the like. BW will supply hard hats, gloves and footwear with reinforced toecaps on request. We normally work from 9am to 5pm (or dark if earlier!).

There are breaks for morning tea/coffee, packed lunch and afternoon tea/coffee. We take our own food and drink.


