

Wendover Arm Trust

The Trust was formed in 1989 as a registered charity to promote and implement the restoration of the Wendover Arm Canal. The aim of the Trust is to restore the 6¾ miles of the Wendover Arm to full navigable order from its junction with the Grand Union Canal at Bulbourne to Wendover.

The Canal was built as a water-feeder for the main line on Tring summit and was made navigable as far as Wendover wharf. Continual problems with leakage meant that the canal was terminated at the stop lock at Tringford pumping station in the early years of the 20th century and allowed to dry-out for 2¼ miles as far as Drayton Beauchamp, where an underground pipeline took water from Wendover and fed it into Wilstone reservoir and to Tringford pumping station.

In 1997, exactly 200 years after the Arm first opened, work began on its restoration, the first stage being to rebuild Little Tring Bridge, demolished less than 25-years previously, and to construct a ¼ mile section of canal from the stop-lock at Little Tring to a new winding hole (for turning boats) beyond the new bridge. In 1990 the Trust was involved in the public enquiry into the proposed A41 Aston Clinton bypass that resulted in the construction of Saxonway bridge over the canal and restoration of a short section of canal from there to Drayton Beauchamp bridge.

Current restoration work is focussed on re-profiling and lining the dry section of the canal from Drayton Beauchamp to Little Tring and this is now within ½ mile of Little Tring. Regular work parties are held and to see the restoration volunteers at work check for the dates at:



Your Personal Plaque – Sponsor the Restoration

As a mark of thanks for any significant donation to the Trust you can have a permanent plaque placed on one of the two wooden footbridges the Trust has built over the canal to record your support for the Trust's work with your name and/or message.

You could use a plaque as a permanent memorial to someone, mark an event or occasion, record a personal dedication or show your organisation's support, donate for one as a surprise gift for someone special to you, or all sorts of other things.

We offer two different types of plaque in three different colours from a simple strip-plaque set into one of the footbridges' steps to a display plaque mounted onto one of the stanchions.

All are cast in zinc with relief lettering and a coloured centre to be weather-proof and scuff-proof. Mounting is permanent with screw fixings. They are all visible to a pedestrian walking or cycling along the towpath or crossing one of the bridges. See inside for full details and you can also see more on our website at:

Where will I find my plaque?

Park at Wilstone reservoir. Walk up to the top of the reservoir walls, turn left and follow the wall of the reservoir to a track, turn right along it then, after 200 yards, left and uphill on the footpath to the towpath.

Bridge 4 is in front of you. Bridge 4a is 400m to your right and the restoration workings will be found to the left of bridge 4.



POSITION ON BRIDGE

Step plaques are flush recessed into the access steps or deck and screwed into place

Stanchion plaques are screwed onto the upright supports
