Wendover Canal Restoration

I am writing to offer my support for the Wendover Canal Trust's project to restore and re-water a further section of the Wendover Canal in Hertfordshire - which includes clearing a 300 yard length full of historic household waste, a major obstacle.

The Trust have been progressively restoring parts of the Canal which have been dry for over 100 years to its former glory and the latest quarter mile stretch has just been re-watered in November this year.

The work of the Trust, a registered charity, is already bringing demonstrable benefits in terms of health and well-being to the community as the focus of a linear green park running through our increasingly urbanised landscape.

It is also transforming the environment including clearing impenetrable brambles resulting from years of neglect, planting 1500 new trees along its margins to date and encouraging the return of a wide variety of wildlife.

In addition it will restore the 'missing link' in the towpath at Little Tring thereby delivering a continuous towpath from Wendover to the Grand Union Canal for the first time since 1913.
