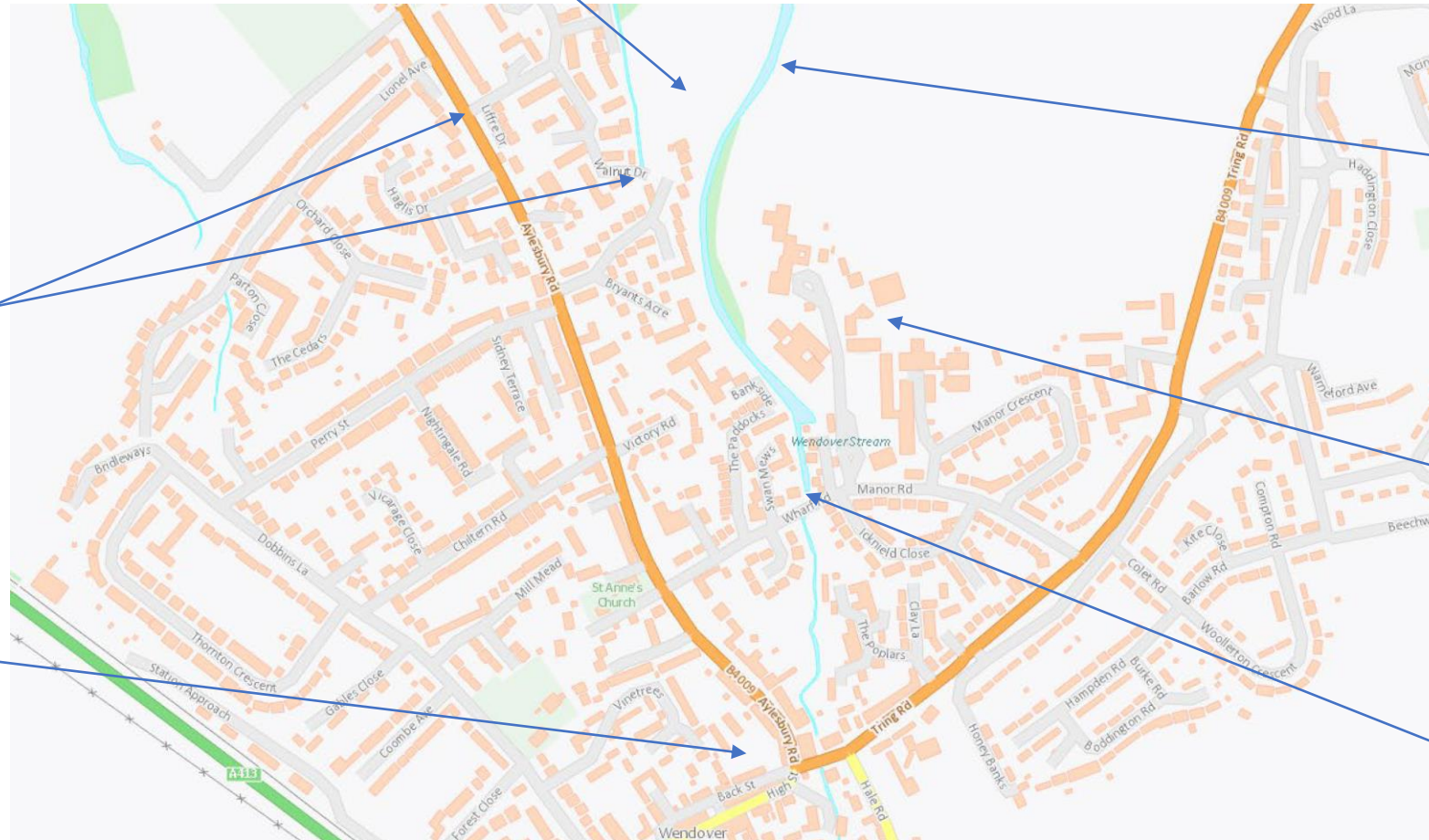
Access to Walnut Tree Meadow via Walnut Drive HP22 6RT or
